



1) LISTEN AND NUMBER THE INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RIGHT ORDER



NEXT, COMBINE EIGHT COUPS OF WATER, NARANJILLA JUICE, CINNAMON, SPICES, AND PANELA IN A LARGE POT.

FIRST, IN A BOWL I PUT A CUP OF WATER TO SOAK THE OATS.

NEXT, BRING TO A BOIL REDUCE THE HEAT AND SIMMER FOR ABOUT 30 MINUTES. ADD THE ORANGE PEEL AND HERBS DURING THE LAST FIVE MINUTES. REMOVE FROM HEAT AND STRAIN.

AFTER THAT, STRAIN THE BLENDED MIX.


FINALLY, SERVE AND ENJOY IT!
