**Erik Weihenmayer, who is blind and famous for climbing Mount Everest, tries kayaking**

**E**rik Weihenmayer, best known as the first and, until now, the only blind man to reach the top of the Mount Everest, simply isn't the type to walk away from challenges. These days, he's paddling toward them! There aren't a lot of blind kayakers running the rapids of the Clear Creek Whitewater Park or the crocodile-infested jungles of Mexico and Guatemala. In fact, there's only one. "I've taken about 50 blind kayakers paddling, but Erik's the only one who has made it to this level," said Chris Wiegand. Chris was an international white water kayaking competitor and now serves as an instructor in Denver. "On the lake, it's one thing. You get them on the river and it's just a different sense of freedom," said Chris.

Even among those who are physically fit and with no disabilities, white water kayaking is considered "extreme" because you have to overcome psychological and physical obstacles. Maybe it has to do with being upside down in a river. Take away the ability to see, and everything inside your head seems bigger than it really is. "I think it's harder (than climbing Everest)," Weihenmayer said. "The biggest challenge is that I have to react so quickly, and almost half the time, things don't go exactly the way you expected them to. So you're always reacting. Even on Everest, you can stop and regroup. Kayaking is hard on my nervous system. I've had bad days where I didn't feel like things were going well and then something clicks and it's just fun."
