### A. NEW LESSON

Verb + -ing, Verb + to infinitive, Verb + object + to infinitive, bare infinitive

Form	Common verbs	Example
- Verb + to-infinitive - Verb + V-ing (But with a change in meaning)	go on, need, remember, try, mean, regret, stop, etc.	<b>Ex:</b> She <b>stopped crying</b> as soon as she saw her mother. (= She was crying, and then she didn't cry anymore.) We <b>stopped to buy</b> some water at the motorway service area. (= We were travelling and we stopped for a short time in order to buy some water.)
- Verb + to infinitive	agree, arrange, attempt, choose, decide, fail, hope, learn, manage, offer, plan, seem, etc.	<b>Ex:</b> I <b>agreed to help</b> Shona with her homework. The driver <b>attempted to remove</b> the flat tire.
- Verb + object + to infinitive	advise, allow, command, forbid, force, invite, order, persuade, remind, teach, tell, etc.	<b>Ex:</b> Peter <b>advised Ron to call</b> the police. Esther <b>reminded her teacher to set</b> some revisions.
- Verb + to infinitive - Verb + object + to infinitive	ask, expect, help, intend, like, love, hate, mean, prefer, want, wish, etc.	<b>Ex:</b> I really <b>expect to go</b> to the party. I really <b>expect Sally to go</b> to the party. <b>*Note this difference:</b> - Dad wants to wash the car = Dad washes the car. - Dad wants John to wash the car = John washes the car.
- Verb + object + bare infinitive (infinitive without "to")	let, make, see, hear, feel, watch, notice, have, etc.	<b>Ex:</b> Let me go. She <b>made him cry</b> .




