

## Past Continuous – Minulý čas priebehový

Minulý priebehový čas používame, keď chceme vyjadriť, že **niekto bol uprostred nejakej situácie alebo deja v určitom čase v minulosti, a že trval dlhší čas.**

I was reading a newspaper.

We were eating breakfast at eight o'clock.

He was living in Paris in 1994.

Minulý čas priebehový použiješ aj v tom prípade, ak v **jednej vete opisuješ činnosti, ktoré prebiehali v minulosti súbežne v rovnakom čase.** Použiješ ho vtedy, keď opisuješ dva deje, kde jeden dej do druhého nezasahoval a obidva deje prebiehali **nezávisle od seba.** Tieto vety môžu, ale aj nemusia, obsahovať spojky „while“ (zatiaľ čo), alebo “at the same time” (zatiaľ čo).

I was reading a book while he was making dinner.

While I was washing the dishes, she was drying them.

We were playing computer games and at the same time you were watching a football match.

**KLADNÁ VETA:** Minulý čas priebehový tvoríme pomocou slovesa „to be“ v minulom čase a teda **WAS a WERE + sloveso s koncovkou -ING**

I \_\_\_\_\_ (watch) TV last night.

**ZAPORNÁ VETA:** Vytvoríme zápor od slovesa was/were a pridáme -ing formu slovesa.

**OTÁZKA:** Otázku tvoríme zmenou slovosledu, pomocou was/were.





