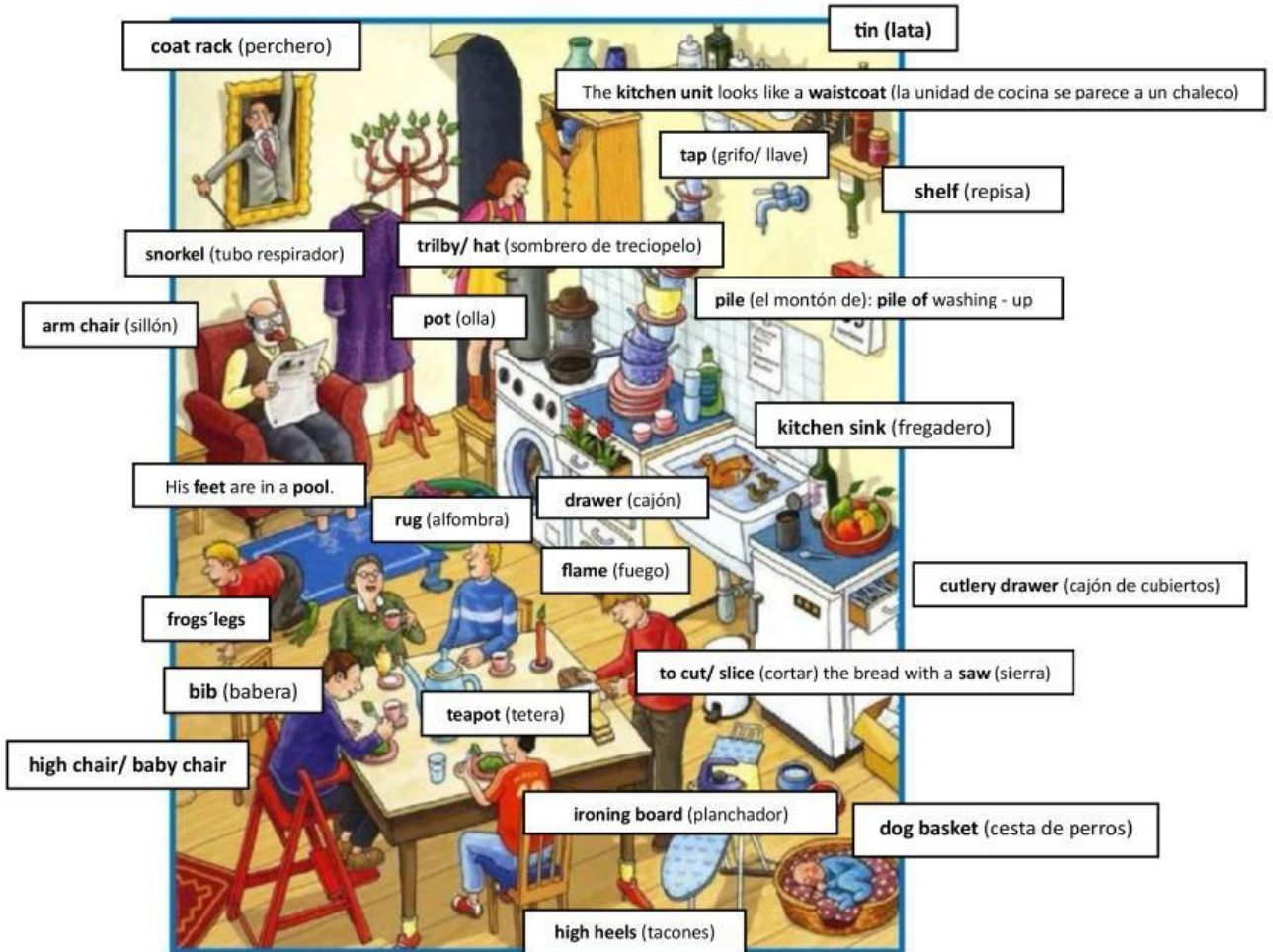


CRAZY KITCHEN!
