BELIEVE IN	to pay an informal visit to a person or a place
LOOK DOWN ON	to be responsible for or to take care of somebody/something/yourself
DROP IN	to deal with or gain control of something/ to return to your usual state of health, happiness, etc. after an illness, a shock, the end of a relationship, etc.
FIIL OUT	to remove something, especially a piece of clothing from your/somebody's body
GET OVER	to stop something from burning or shining
COME ACROSS	to get rid of something that you no longer want
LOOK AFTER	to think that you are better than somebody
PUT OUT	to agree to do something that you do not want to do
LIFT UP	To raise from a lower to a higher position
TAKE OFF	to give something to a person in authority, especially a piece of work or something that is lost
THROW AWAY	to meet or find somebody/something by chance
GIVE IN	to become involved in something; to start something
HAND IN	to feel certain that somebody/something exists
GET INTO	to put on a piece of clothing to see if it fits and how it looks
TRY ON	to complete a form, etc. by writing information on it
