George W Carver was always interested in plants
Cotton plants use most the nutrients in the soil
The soil becomes dried out
Carver was dedicated to helping poor African American farmers
The farmers rotated their crops
Farmers had too many peanuts to sell, eat, and store
Peanuts became more and more popular
Carver had done so much work with the farmer and peanuts

He came up with a plan to put nutrients back in the soil
Carver invented over 300 more uses for the peanut, to help the farmers get rid of and use their peanuts
When he was a child, he was known as the "plant doctor"
The soil was enriched, and farmers were able to grow cotton every other year
Peanuts became one of the top six crops in the United States
The soil becomes dried out
The United Peanut Association of America was formed
Cotton will no longer grow on the land
