In the first 48 hours more than 65,000 people watched it.</p>
<p>B</p> <p>A lip dub is a kind of music video. A group of people sing and dance and a cameraperson films them. Later a filmmaker adds the original song to the video. In the video you hear the original song. You don't hear the people on the video. The idea for the first school lip dub came from Germany.
