NETIQUETTE – A WHIM OR A MUST?

Online communication has become part of our everyday lives as it's fast and easy. However, it also has its disadvantages: when communicating online you don't get to see a person's body language, and you don't hear their tone of voice. The only tool of communication you have is the typed word. It's easy then to be misunderstood or even to insult someone. That is why it is very important to become familiar with the rules of netiquette – tips on how to communicate online. Another essential thing to consider is that you are communicating with a real person, so before you send or post anything, imagine how they might feel when they read your message or post.

HOW TO BE POLITE ON THE NET

- Think about the recipients of your message or post. Will it be read by your close friends or will it be public?
- Adopt the right tone and level of formality – don't overuse emoticons or capital letters.

- Express your opinions politely, and rely on facts and data which can be checked.
- Avoid sarcasm and irony even if you think someone is wrong.
- Never post or send anything when angry or frustrated – wait for your emotions to cool down.
