bench

a building with walls and roof made of glass or plastic, used for growing plants that require controlled conditions.

bushes

dense, woody shrubs with multiple stems and foliage, often used for landscaping.

pot

a long seat typically made of wood or metal, often found in parks or gardens.

clothes lines

a barrier made of posts and wire or wood panels to enclose an area or mark a boundary.

lawn

a section of ground planted with flowers, often bordered by edging materials.

swing

an outdoor space adjoining a house, typically paved and used for dining or relaxation.

hose

outdoor structures or devices used for hanging laundry to dry.

wheelie bins

an area of grass, typically mowed and maintained, used for recreational purposes or as part of a garden.

shed

large, wheeled containers used for storing and transporting household waste.

flower bed

a container, usually made of clay or ceramic, used for growing plants.

glasshouse

a suspended seat attached to ropes or chains, used for recreation or play.

fence

a flexible tube used for conveying water from a source to a desired location.
