****Notes on Tenses:****

- ****Present Simple:****

- Used for general truths and habits.
- Example: "Mia and Lily wake up early in the morning."

- ****Present Continuous:****

- Used for actions happening right now or around the present time.
- Example: "Mia and Lily are walking through the park."

- ****Past Simple:****

- Used for completed actions in the past.
- Example: "The girls found a perfect spot to set up camp."

- ****Past Continuous:****

- Used for actions that were happening at a specific point in the past.
- Example: "As the sun was rising, Mia and Lily were packing their backpacks."

- ****Future Simple:****

- Used for predictions or plans in the future.
- Example: "They will sleep under the stars at night."

- ****Present Perfect Simple:****

- Used for actions that started in the past and continue into the present.

- Example: "They have fewer worries and more appreciation for the park."
- ****Present Perfect Continuous:****
 - Used for actions that started in the past and continue up to the present moment.
 - Example: "Mia and Lily have been exploring the park all day."
