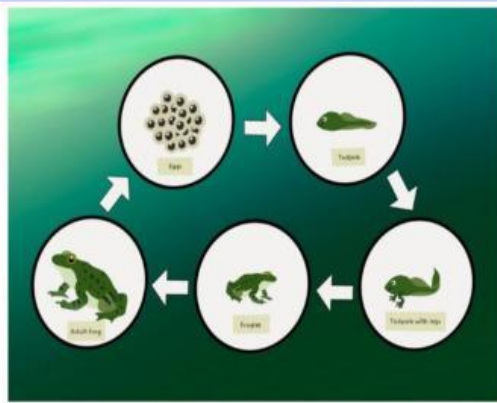




Tad and Polly

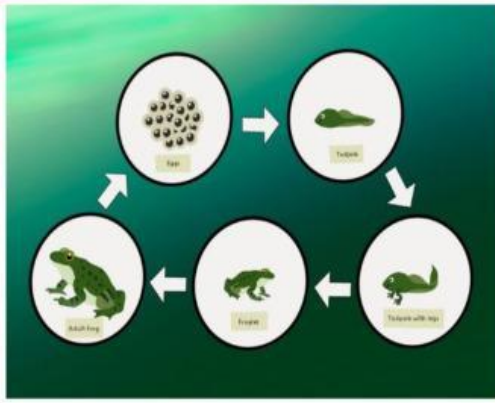
