MOBILE PHONES VOCABULARY

- **(to) text** – to send someone a text (SMS) message; a text message.
- **to call (somebody) back** – to return a phone call.
- **to hang up** – to end a phone call.
- **to break up** – when a phone call is interrupted by a poor signal.
- **to pocket dial** – accidentally dial someone while your phone is in your pocket.
- **hands-free** – describes something that is designed to function without the use of hands.
