

Read about the third trimester in pregnancy and decide whether the sentences below are true (T) or false (F).

The third trimester signals the end of a pregnancy. At the end of a pregnancy, foetal development continues. By about week 28, the eyes are partially open and the eyelashes are formed. The baby also gains weight which smooths out wrinkles in the skin. The baby's bones are fully developed, but are still soft and flexible. Even though the lungs aren't fully formed, breathing is practised. In week 31, the nervous system starts to control temperature regulation. Soon after, the baby's pupils can constrict, dilate and detect light.
