Section R2 (13 marks)

Read the passage and answer all the questions.

Women's Football

Women's football is becoming more popular. There are 29 million girls and women playing football worldwide and there are 176 national teams from different countries. The first international game was in 1920 between England and France. England won 2-0 and 25,000 people went to watch.

The first women's football World Cup was in China in 1991. The USA won, but American television didn't show the tournament, so most of the country didn't know about it. At that time, there were only 12 teams. In 1999, when the World Cup was in the USA, there were 16 teams. In 2015, there were 24 teams, and countries like Spain and Costa Rica played for the first time. The USA has been the most successful team. They have won the competition three times. The 2015 World Cup took place in Canada and 1.35 million people went to watch. Many more people watched it on television.

Women's football is becoming more well-known, but there are still differences with men's football. The winners of the 2015 competition, the USA, received \$2m dollars, but Germany, who won the men's competition in 2014, received \$35m. Some people think that women's football is slow, but others think that it is as exciting as men's football.
