No one knows exactly when glue was first used but we know it was over 6,000 years ago. The ancient Greeks used it to fix pottery¹ and make furniture. They made glue from things like egg whites, blood, bones, milk, cheese, vegetables and grains². The Egyptians used glue to make furniture and fix papyrus scrolls³.

In the middle of the 20th century, Dr. Harry Coover accidentally invented a new kind of strong glue made from chemicals. His "super glue" is thought to be one of the most important inventions of the 20th century.

Bonus Factoids

- Super glue is so strong that it can lift up a car and hold it in the air for a few seconds.
- In 1960, a German company invented a glue stick. This form of glue is found in offices and schools all over the world.
- There is a special form of Dr. Coover's glue in a spray can. It was used to stop the bleeding when soldiers were injured during the Vietnam War.
