B. GRAMMAR – IMPERATIVES (Câu mệnh lệnh)

- **Định nghĩa:** Câu mệnh lệnh hay còn gọi là câu cầu khiến là mẫu câu dùng để yêu cầu, đề nghị hoặc ra lệnh người khác làm hay không làm một điều gì đó.
- **Cấu trúc & Phân loại:**

	Câu mệnh lệnh trực tiếp	Câu mệnh lệnh gián tiếp
Định nghĩa	Là những câu không có chủ ngữ, đứng đầu câu là động từ nguyên mẫu không có “to”. Có kèm theo từ “please” ở đầu hoặc cuối câu thể hiện ý trang trọng, lịch sự.	Là những câu mệnh lệnh sử dụng với các động từ như: order (ra lệnh)/ ask (yêu cầu)/ say (nói)/ tell (báo) .
Cấu trúc	(+) Verb/ Be + O. (-) Don't + verb/ be + O.	(+) (S) + order/ ask/ say/ tell + O + to V-inf. (-) (S) + order/ ask/ say/ tell + O + NOT+ to V-inf.
Ví dụ	– Stand up, please! (<i>Hãy đứng dậy!</i>) – Please keep silent! (<i>Làm ơn giữ yên lặng!</i>) – Don't be silly! (<i>Đừng ngốc nghếch thế!</i>)	– The teacher asked Tom to answer her question. (<i>Cô giáo yêu cầu Tom trả lời câu hỏi của cô ấy.</i>) – Please ask him not to do it again! (<i>Làm ơn bảo cậu ta đừng làm như thế nữa!</i>)

2. Đưa ra một mệnh lệnh trực tiếp, yêu cầu người khác làm gì đó.	Give it to me! (<i>Hãy đưa nó cho tôi!</i>)
3. Đưa ra lời mời.	Have some drinks! (<i>Uống chút gì nhé!</i>)
4. Được sử dụng ở các biển báo hoặc thông cáo.	Turn right. (<i>Rẽ phải.</i>)
5. Đưa ra lời khuyên.	Don't drive too fast! (<i>Đừng lái xe quá nhanh!</i>)
