I love bananas. They're my favorite fruit, and I eat one every day. But have you ever thought about where bananas come from? How do they get to our shops?

The answer is that they come from all over the world. Bananas grow in tropical countries, like Costa Rica, Ecuador and the Philippines. In these places, it's hot and there's a lot of rain, which is perfect for growing bananas.

When the bananas are ready, workers on huge plantations cut them down and put them into big boxes. Then they load the boxes onto trucks and take them to a port. At the port, the boxes are loaded onto ships, which carry the bananas to other countries.

In my country, the UK, we don't grow bananas because it's too cold. So we import them. That means we buy them from other countries. In fact, we import more bananas than any other country in Europe! Every week, we eat 140 million bananas!

When the ships arrive in the UK, the bananas are taken to special warehouses called ripening rooms. The temperature and the humidity (the amount of water in the air) in these rooms are controlled, so that the bananas stay fresh. After about a week, the bananas are ready to eat.

Finally, the bananas are delivered to our local shops. There are different ways to do this. Some supermarkets have their own lorries, which drive the bananas to the shops. Other supermarkets pay delivery companies to bring the bananas to them. Either way, the bananas end up on the shelves, and then we can buy them and take them home.

So next time you eat a banana, think about its long journey. It's amazing how something so small can travel so far!
