This type of selection lets a program choose what to do from several options based on a value or condition.

A written statement of an algorithm using a semiformal language with limited vocabulary.

A series of actions that is completed in a specific order.

Indicates that a decision needs to be made, followed by an appropriate action derived from that decision.

Step by step instructions that will transform input into output.

If the condition is true, the specified block of code is executed; otherwise, it is skipped.

A set of standard shaped boxes that are connected by flow lines to represent an algorithm.
