They are a family.
We live together.



She is a doctor.

Object pronouns (me you him her it us you them) are used when as the **OBJECT** of a verb, receiving the action.



This is a King's guard.
— **protects** —.



She's a police officer.
— **ask** — **directions**.



They are my parents.
— **visit** — **frequently**.

I get — ! She told —
they were healthy.
