2. A farmer has 36 eggs. He wants to pack them into cartons with 6 eggs in each carton. How many cartons will he need?
3. John has 48 stickers. He wants to share them equally among 6 pages in his sticker album. How many stickers will he stick on each page?
4. There are 35 children in a classroom. If they want to form groups with 7 children in each group, how many groups will they have?
5. Susan has 40 sweets. She wants to put them into packets with 4 sweets in each packet. How many packets will she need?
6. A bakery baked 60 cupcakes. They want to pack them into boxes with 12 cupcakes in each box. How many boxes will they need?
7. Tom has 56 crayons. He wants to share them equally among 8 friends. How many crayons will each friend get?
8. There are 42 apples in a basket. If Sarah wants to put them into bags with 6 apples in each bag, how many bags will she need?
9. A toy shop has 50 teddy bears. If they want to display them equally on 5 shelves, how many teddy bears will be on each shelf?
10. Mary has 30 beads. She wants to make bracelets with 5 beads in each bracelet. How many bracelets can she make?
