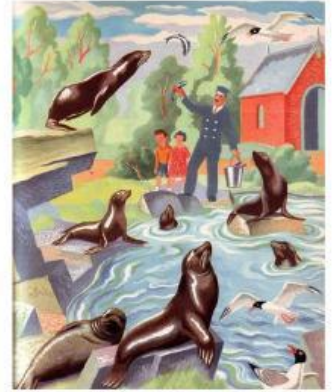


The School Trip
