## *Seven reasons* TO GO TRAVELING

- 4 Because you want to learn about yourself. Getting away from home and work means you have time to reflect on your life and decide if you want to make any changes.
- 5 Because you need to recharge your batteries. If you find it hard to keep yourself away from work, traveling can help you switch off from all the things you need to do and get some well-earned rest.
- 6 Because you want to celebrate a special occasion with friends or family. Travel can create precious memories that you can look back on together.
- 7 Because you always wanted to. Don't keep putting it off or you'll never get around to it!
