

## Prefix Practice: **dis-, non-, un-**

A **prefix** is a word part attached to the beginning of a word to change the meaning of that word.

Prefixes that mean **not** or the opposite of:

**dis** + believe = disbelieve (not believe)

**non** + toxic = nontoxic (not toxic)

**un** + expected = unexpected (not expected)

**Directions:** Add the prefix **dis-**, **non-**, or **un-** to each base word to form a new word. There are some words that can be paired with more than one potential prefix.
