 2. Everybody **had been staying** at a hostel for two weeks before you came here. (stay)

Future Tense / will

1) I hope I a hotel for every budget. (find)
 2) I hope everybody a hotel for every budget. (find)

Future Tense / be going to

1) It is certain. These historical sites in UNESCO World Heritage List soon. (be)
 2. I know everybody a hotel for every budget. (find)

Future Continuous Tense

1. I .. **will be using** a map to go to the camp site at this time tomorrow. (use)
 2. Everybody **will be buying** tickets in this shop at this time next year. (buy)

Future Perfect Tense

1) I ... **will have used** ... a map to go to the camp site by 10 tomorrow. (use)

Future Perfect Continuous Tense
