What are the tenses used and what's the difference in meaning?

1. He **goes** to work.
2. He's **going** to work.

1. She **lives** in a hotel.
2. She **is living** in a hotel.

1. They **are** stupid.
2. They **are being** stupid.

1. It **comes** from Poland.
2. It's **coming** from Poland.

1. Our teacher **always gives** us a lot of things to do.
2. Our teacher **is always giving** us a lot of things to do.

1. I **work** on Saturdays.
2. I'm **working** on Saturday.

... and a few teacher jokes ;)

1. Teacher: What *is coming* / *comes* before eight?
