


The Album Library of the Golestan Palace in Tehran, Iran.

The Album Library of the Golestan Palace was established by Naser ed-Din Shah and is considered today as one of the largest and richest centers of historical photos in the entire world. It contains a collection of more than 1040 old albums which in turn contain photos that date back to the Qajar dynasty. Additionally, it's home to over 4000 photos of different sizes- most of which are initially made to fit in photo containers known as Axdaans that were once used instead of albums.



For the past years, staff of the library managed to preserve and classify photos by subject and size after they were kept under improper conditions. Today, they are made into over 300 albums and put on exhibit.
