USES OF ORDINAL NUMBERS

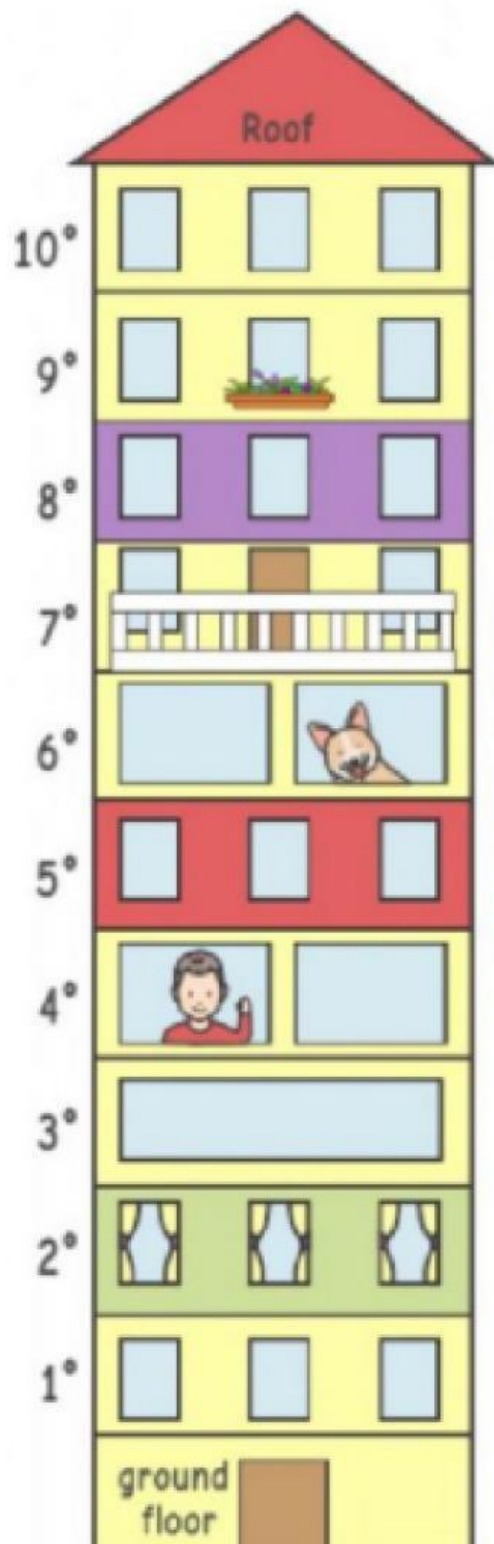
DATES: Her birthday is on the **29th**.
