ORIGINS OF A NAME

The names for the days of the week in some modern languages come from the gods of Ancient Rome.



For example, *Day of Venus*, the Roman goddess of love, is the modern Spanish *Viernes*. With the expansion of the Roman Empire, the Germanic and Nordic people adopted the Roman practice. They modified the system to use the corresponding gods from their culture, like *Frige*, the Nordic goddess of love. So both *Friday* and *Viernes* are the *Day of Love!*
