

GRAMMAR Future Continuous

We use the Future Continuous to talk about actions that will be in progress at a specific time in the future.

She'll be sailing in August.

We won't be studying for exams in two weeks' time.

Will they be living abroad in five years' time?

When will you be travelling?

We can use the Future Continuous with these time expressions: *in August/three years' time, at 5 o' clock, this time next week/month*
