**EARNING about Superlative ADJECTIVES.**

A **SUPERLATIVE** in grammar serves as an **adjective** highlighting a noun as the ultimate example of a particular quality, denoting superiority. It characterizes a noun possessing more of a specific quality than any other.

**Superlative adjective** takes the **comparatives** of nouns to the **highest** degree.

Examples include :

- the coldest day (the epitome of coldness, surpassing all others)
- days in temperature
- the craziest man
- the fluffiest cloud

In English, most superlatives are formed by adding **-EST** to an existing adjective, as demonstrated above.

**For superlatives, add “-est” to single syllable. As well as “st” if the word ends with an e and add “iest” to two-Syllable Adjectives Ending in “Y” to an existing adjective.**

**Superlative ADJECTIVES Form Rules****Rule 1: One syllable add “-est”**

Adjective	Tall	Big
<i>Superlative</i> Adj add <b>st/-est</b>	<b>Tal-est</b>	<b>Big-est</b>

**Rule 2: Two-Syllable Adjectives Ending in “Y”**

Adjective	Easy	Busy
<i>Superlative</i> Adj remove “y” add “-iest”	<b>Easiest</b>	<b>Busiest</b>
