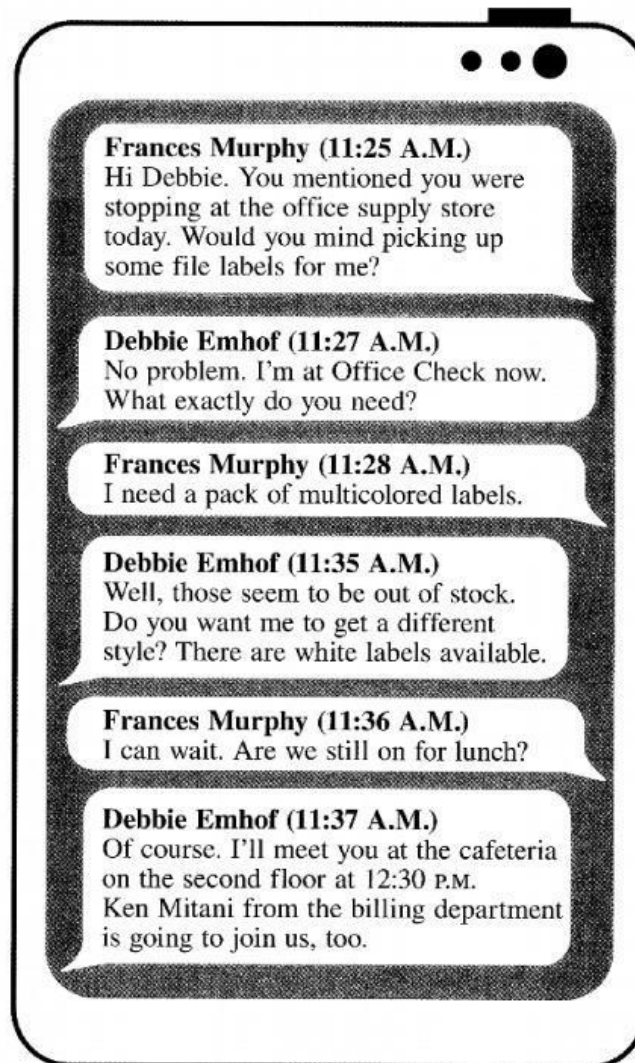

### Personal trainer helps locals keep fit at popular gym

Three years ago, when personal trainer Carol Yoo invested her life savings to open Prism Gym, her friends were concerned. "You're taking a big risk," a colleague told her. — [1] —. However, the investment proved to be worth it.

Today, Prism Gym has 350 clients and 21 staff members. The facility offers 24-hour access and 12 personal trainers. It currently occupies a 2,200-square foot space on the second floor of the Mandel Building and will move to a larger space on the first floor of the same building next month. "I didn't think I would need more space so soon," Ms. Yoo said. — [2] —.

Yoo, a Delmax City native, previously worked as a personal trainer at the downtown Wellness Gym. She quit when Plus Fitness, Inc. bought out the facility and reduced her work hours, and soon started Prism Gym with an initial equipment purchase of \$50,000. "I paid \$30,000 up front, and the rest on installments. Thanks to our surprisingly rapid growth, I paid off the remaining \$20,000 earlier than planned," she said. — [3] —.

Yoo has done no marketing since the gym opened. "All of our members are Delmax City residents who joined via positive word of mouth from other clients," she said. A typical member, she explained, is a beginner with little gym experience. — [4] —. Because of that, all of the Prism Gym staff are "friendly and approachable."
