



**Countable and uncountable nouns.** Choose whether the following nouns are countable or uncountable write the plural noun for the countable ones.

**Don't use article *The***

When you want to talk about a category or group in general, use no article.

- **General:** Cats can be great pets
- **Specific:** *The* cats in that pet store are expensive.

Use no article before abstract nouns such as feelings or ideas (usually nouns you can't count).

- **wrong:** The patience is a virtue.
- **correct:** Patience is a virtue.
