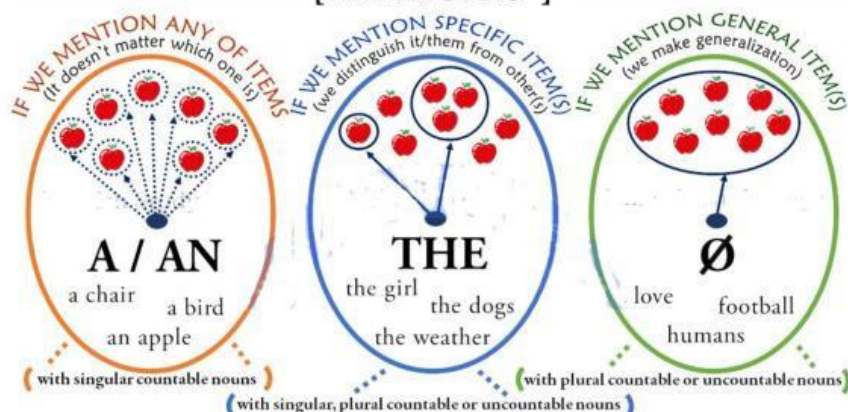

- **General:** Cats can be great pets
- **Specific:** The cats in that pet store are expensive.

Use no article before abstract nouns such as feelings or ideas (usually nouns you can't count).

- **wrong:** The patience is a virtue.
- **correct:** Patience is a virtue.
