No.	Aspect	Criteria
1	Unity	Paragraph must focus solely on a single idea, point, or argument that is being discussed in order to maintain a sense of unity.
2	Coherence	Paragraph must include a topic, supporting, and concluding sentence that are built upon each other in an organized manner in order to help reader understand the main point that is being presented and discussed.
3	Clarity	Paragraph must be well written and organized that will ensure the intended idea, information, or message of the paragraph is clear to the reader.
4	Grammar	Paragraph must be written and developed based on proper grammar structure. Proper grammar ensures that the meaning of the text is clear and easily understood by the reader.
5	Mechanics	Paragraph must be build and construct upon suitable and proper mechanics of writing. Mechanics, which includes spelling, punctuation, capitalization, and formatting, is important in writing a paragraph. Correct punctuation and capitalization, for example, can clarify the structure of sentences and indicate the beginning and end of ideas.
