

Modals of OBLIGATION

The main verbs of obligation are; **MUST, HAVE TO, SHOULD**. The past of **have to / has to** is **had**. **Must** is for personal obligations. **Have to** is for general obligations.

- You **must** stop here.
- You **have to** wear a seatbelt when you drive.
- You **must** answer at least one question.
- You **should** call Mary. I know she misses you a lot.
- She looks sick. She **should** go home.
- I **must** do some work.
- You **shouldn't** have smoked.
- I **have to** return the book now.
- I **had to** wear a school uniform when I was a child.
