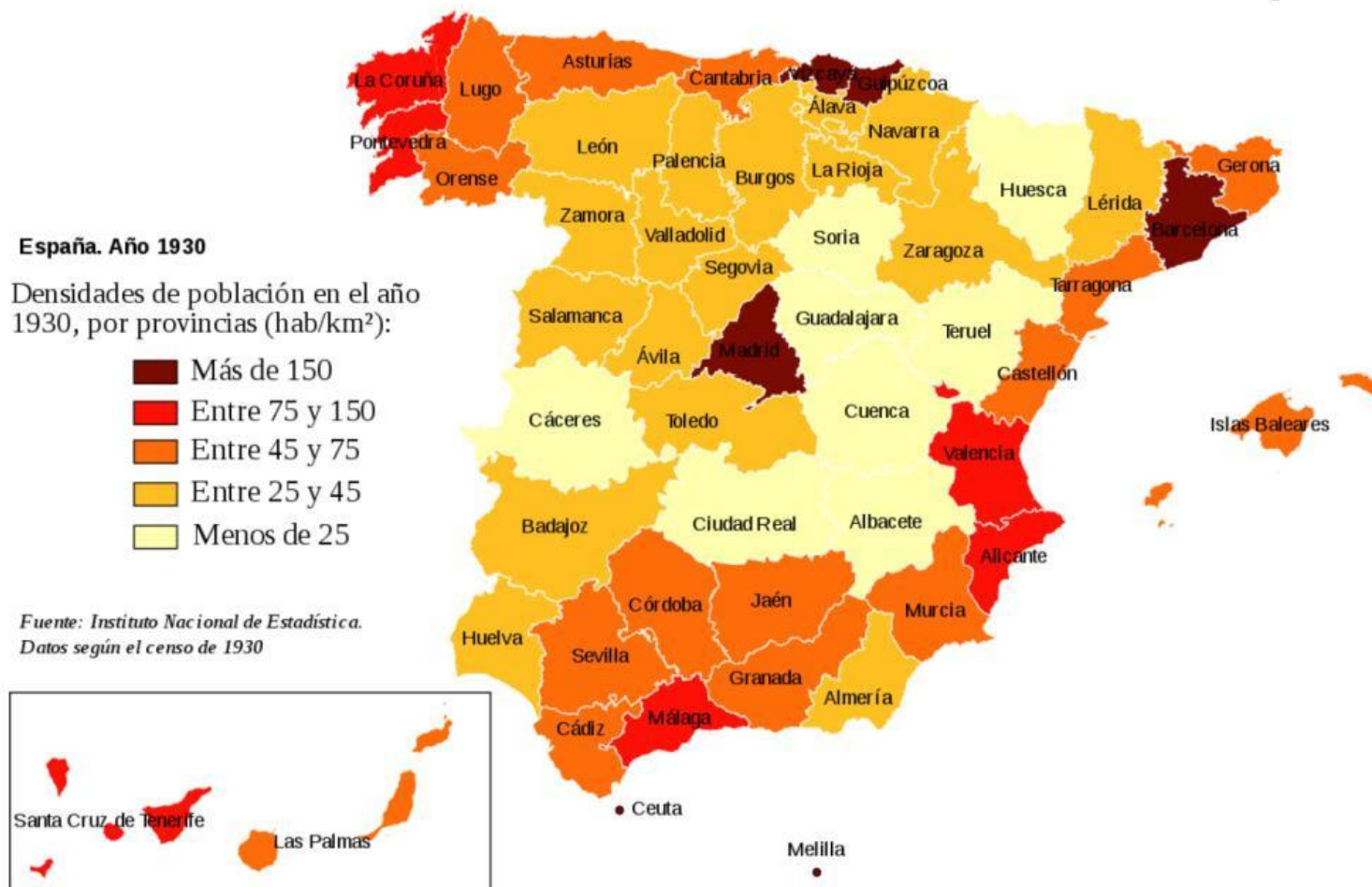


DISTRIBUCIÓN DE LA POBLACIÓN EN ESPAÑA (1930)
