Buses



1. While only a few persons can fit in a car, many people can travel on one bus. This means that there would be less cars on the road, less traffic jams and less pollution in the atmosphere.
2. People can be picked up and dropped off to school and work on time because the buses run every day and pick up and drop off people at many bus stops along the road.
3. Riding the bus allows people to rest, look out the window or talk to their friends while they are on their way to work or school.
4. People feel safe riding in buses because buses don't travel very fast, so they don't have as many accidents as cars.

Trains



1. Trains can carry lots of people to work and school
2. Trains can get people to work and school quickly because they run on a railroad track away from main roads and there are no traffic lines to slow the trains down.
3. People can read books or newspapers, look out the window, or talk to their friends on their way to school or work.
4. Trains stop at many stations along the way so that people can get on and off freely.
5. Trains don't cause traffic jams or make lots of dirt in the air because one train takes the place of many cars.
