

PRESENT CONTINUOUS

Form	Affirmative	S + am/is/are + V-ing She is cooking.
	Negative	S + am/is/are + not + V-ing She is not cooking.
	Interrogative	Am/is/are + S + V-ing Is she cooking?

Usage	Example	Time Expressions
Action happening now	Jim is watching television at the moment.	Now, at the moment, currently ...

y + ing = ying



play = playing
fly = flying
study = studying



e = e + ing



dance = dancing
fake = faking
rhyme = rhyming

ee + ing = eeing



see = seeing
flee = fleeing
agree = agreeing

ie = i + ying



die = dying
lie = lying
tie = tying



c/v/c* = double final c + ing



run = running
put = putting
stop = stopping
