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ANGLOSAXON GENITIVE (POSSESSIVE CASE)

OWNER 'S + OBJECT

Jeremiah's car
The car of JEREMIAH

Apostrophe + s

Don't confuse Genitive with To Be Apostrophe
Sam's with his wife at Pat's House

*QUESTION + Yes/No+Proun+Be+OWNER'S (answer)
Is Ann's bag? No, it's Laura's (No, it is of LAURA)

*OWNER-S (plural) + APOSTROPHE + OBJECT
Students' book (Singular: Student's book)

* PROPER NOUNS ending S+'S or APOSTROPHE
James's /iz/ or James'

* TIME EXPRESSIONS: Four day's Carnival

* NO genitive with objects, use OF: The top of the hill
