1. The table below presents the food consumption per a person weekly in a European country in 1992, 2002 and 2012.

Vegetables	2140	2190	2220
Meat	1148	1211	1132
Wheat	837	920	977
Bean	532	546	590
Cheese	113	125	125

(1) The table **shows** the trend in the **number of food** which a person **to used** in one week in

a European country in 1992, 2002 and 2012.

(2) Overall, it is noticeable that the **consumption** of Vegetables, wheat, bean **to rose**,

while that of meat **to declined**. And the consumption of cheese **rose minimally**.

(3) In all **three years** above, vegetables **were** the most **consumed food** and increased

sharply each year, **that increased** from **2140 in 1992 to 2190 in 2002 and 2220 in 2002**.

(4) **Besides that**, the consumption of wheat and bean **to grow** slowly from 837 to 977

for wheat and 532 to 590 for beans **after 20 years**.

(5) Meanwhile, people **increase** their meat consumption in a week from 1148 to 1211 in

the first ten years, then **which** declined to 1132 in next **ten years**.

(6) And **the number** of cheese comsumption **to rose** from 113 to 125 in 2002, which
were to remain the same.
