

# The British way of life?

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A new survey on the free time and shopping habits of British people is published this week – and it shows that we still love football, going to pubs, watching TV and eating fish and chips! Here are some of the results from the survey.





- The British are **always** happy when they're socialising. 55% of <sup>a</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ and 44% of <sup>b</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ go to a bar or pub with their friends **every week**.
- About <sup>c</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ of adults go to a festival or a concert at least once a year and <sup>d</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ go to the theatre. About 25% go to a museum or an art gallery.
- British people **generally** watch TV for about <sup>e</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ hours every day – and about <sup>f</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ of men have dinner and watch TV at the same time!
- The average British person spends more than <sup>g</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ hours online **every month**, and a <sup>h</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ that time is on social networking sites like Facebook and Twitter.
- <sup>i</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ than half of all adults in the UK do some sport every month. About <sup>j</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ British people go swimming and <sup>k</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ play football – but 32% watch football on TV **once or twice a week**.
- British people **normally** go on holiday **once a year**, but <sup>l</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ people have two or more holidays a year. The most popular holiday destination is <sup>m</sup> \_\_\_\_\_.
- <sup>n</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ adults go to a McDonald's restaurant **every three months**, but <sup>o</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ go to a traditional fish and chip shop.
- The British spend about £48 million on <sup>p</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ and £56 million on <sup>q</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ every month.
- And every British person eats <sup>r</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ of chocolate every year – more than any other country in the world!
