


Beau – The Barking Genius¹

We've all heard stories about dogs that can do tricks, but Beau's story is truly amazing². Believe it or not, this 12-year-old dog from Montana, U.S.A., can solve math problems³!

Beau's owner, David Madsen, first noticed⁴ Beau's intelligence when he was a puppy. That's when he decided to teach his pet math. How did he do this? First he put one dog biscuit⁵ in front of Beau and taught him to bark once. Next, he added another biscuit and taught him to bark twice. Then he took one away and taught him to bark once. Madsen continued doing this with more dog biscuits. Each time Beau barked the right number of times, Madsen gave him a biscuit.

After a while, Beau learned to do math without dog biscuits. He can now answer what $2 + 3$ is by barking five times. Beau can also solve problems like: "There are five dogs in the park. Three dogs leave. How many dogs are left?" But Beau's math skills⁶ don't end there. Beau can tell you how old he is (though the answer is quite noisy), and he can even solve simple math problems that are written on a piece of paper. For example, Beau barks three times when he sees the problem $3x = 9$, $x =$.

Beau barks the right answer about 85% of the time. But there's one kind of question that he always gets wrong. When Madsen asks him what $4 - 4$ is, Beau just starts barking and doesn't stop because he doesn't understand what zero⁷ means.
