COUNTABLE NOUNS**

+ consonant sound

E.g.: There's **a** café.

+ vowel sound

E.g.: There's **an** old bridge.

**PLURAL COUNTABLE &
UNCOUNTABLE NOUNS**

+ affirmative.

E.g.: There are **some** parks in the city.

+ negative

E.g.: There *aren't* **any** good shops here
