Our biggest challenges (part 1)

In the future, our planet will face many challenges. But will they come from space, the Earth, or even from ourselves?



Space

On February 15, 2013, an asteroid entered the Earth's atmosphere over Russia. When it exploded, 30 km above the ground, it was traveling at about 65,000 km/h. Many glass windows broke in the explosion and about 1,000 people were injured. The largest piece of the asteroid landed in a lake. Many scientists think that another large asteroid will hit the Earth one day. It will probably land in the ocean, and it will cause floods.



The Earth

From March to May, 2010, a volcanic eruption in Iceland created an enormous cloud over Europe. It didn't cause any injuries or disease, but planes couldn't fly for more than a week. The eruption cost \$7.3 billion. But that was just a normal volcano. Supervolcanoes are over 1,000 times bigger. There is one under Yellowstone Park in the U.S. It is about the same size as Mount Everest. One day, it will erupt!



Humans

By 2050, experts think there will be over 9.7 billion people on the planet. They worry that many people won't have food, water, or homes. Cities will become more crowded; traffic and pollution will get worse. More people will use more energy, and this will cause climate change, too. Is overpopulation our biggest challenge?
