Parallel Structure Worksheet

Review the Sentences for Errors

Parallel structure means using the same pattern of words to show that two or more ideas have the same level of importance. This can happen at the word, phrase, or clause level.

The usual way to join parallel structures is with the use of coordinating conjunctions such as "and" or "or."

Examples: David bought a cardigan, a pair of shoes, and a tie.

Martha was both an industrious student and an excellent writer.

Please review the following sentences for errors in parallel structure. Correct the sentence by rewriting it. Not all sentences are incorrect.
