You said 'Put some keys on the bread and put some jam on the keys.'

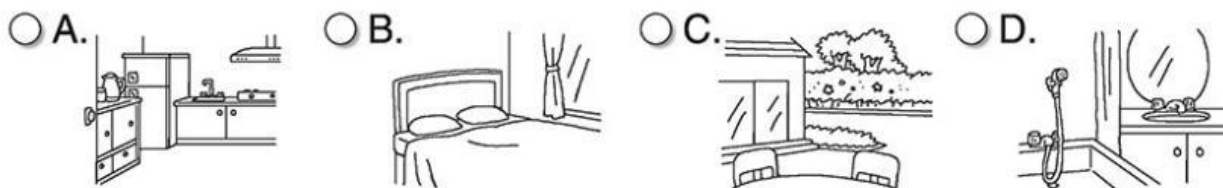
