'Your homework is to take a funny holiday photo.'

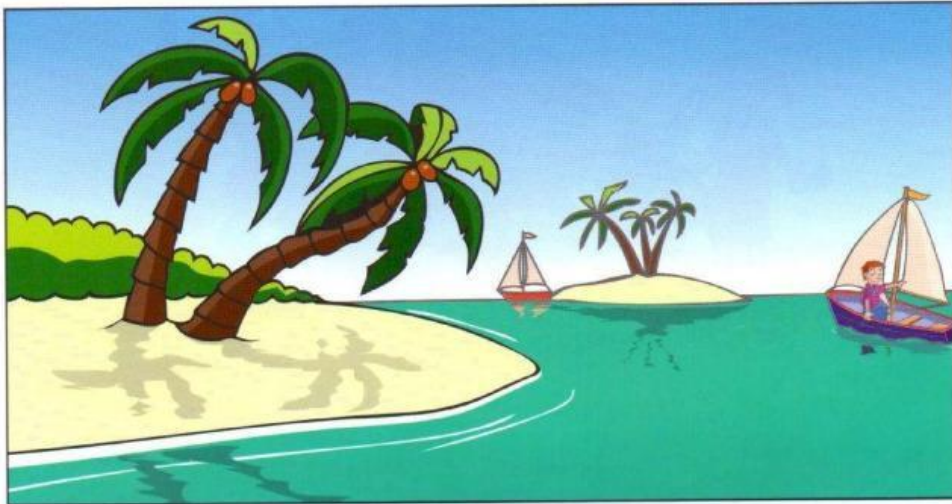
