**Rudy** That's right, yep. We're <sup>2</sup>*going / about* to take off approximately half an hour from now.

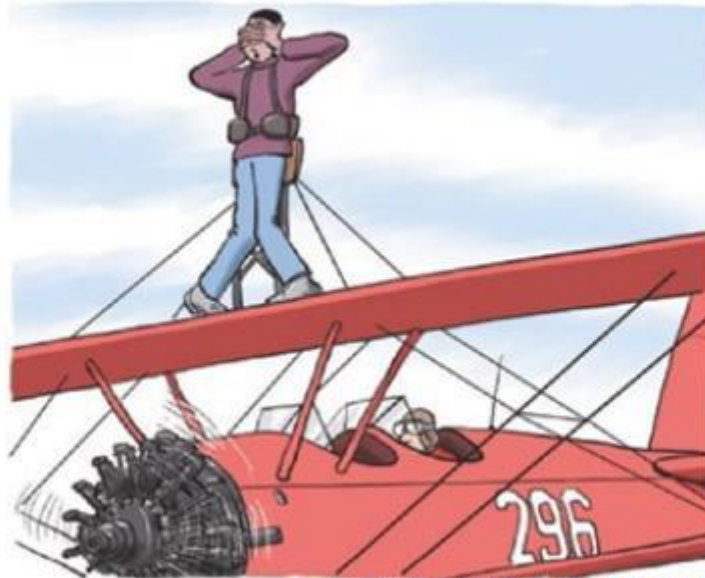
**I** And what <sup>3</sup>*are you / will you be* doing exactly? You're <sup>4</sup>*due / going* to stand on the wing, right?
