


Parts of a Book

protein—a nutrient; proteins are the building blocks of bones, muscles, skin, and blood.

skeletal muscle—the kind of muscle that connects to and moves bones in the body

smooth muscle—the kind of muscle that makes many of the organs in the body

tendons—bands of tissue that connect muscles to bones

tricep—a muscle in the upper arm; the tricep works with the bicep to move the lower arm.
